

### **Communication and Language**


- Retell a story with story language

#### **Maths**

- Zero and comparing numbers to 5
- Composition of 4 and 5

### **Understanding the World**

- How do we get to school? Introduce a range of transport and where they can be found.
- Look at transport in this country and compare to other countries.
- How has transport changed over time?
- Look at features of the local environment and compare with other areas.
- Use Bee Bots and simple maps to encourage navigational language.
- Can children differentiate between land and sea?
- Look at significant figures who have contributed to transport in the past e.g. inventors, space travel, explorers.
- Google Earth, NASA and space travel.

### **RE/Festivals**

- Which people are special and why?
- Chinese New Year (22<sup>nd</sup> January Year of the Rabbit)

### Literacy

- Listen and enjoy sharing and joining in with a wide range of books, poems and songs.
- Phonics start to learn to read and write letter sounds (Phase 3)
- Develop listening and speaking skills in a range of contexts.
- Write recognisable letters and begin to form these correctly.
- Start to blend known sounds to read words e.g. shop, duck, meet
- Write their name and short words from memory using the correct letter formation.

### **Expressive Arts and Design**

- Design and make vehicles for a purpose.
- Junk Modelling houses, bridges, boats, transport etc
- Learn a traditional song and dance and perform it to an audience.
- Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills.
- Develop storylines in their pretend play.
