Music Club (for all ages)

Mr Whawell (from Sing Education) will be running a Music Club this term for all school years. It will run every Monday from 3.15pm to 4.15pm commencing 11th September until 11th December. This is open to children across the federation.

The cost for the hour for KS2 children will be ± 3.00 per session and will be ± 39.00 for the whole term – 13 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).

Sports Club

Mr Bullock will be leading a Sports club at Middleham on a Tuesday. The children will be given the opportunity to explore a range of different sporting and fitness activities throughout the sessions. Sessions will start on 12^{th} September until 12^{th} December. The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £39.00 for the whole term – 13 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).

Lego Club (2nd Half Term only for all ages)

I will be leading a Lego Club <u>at Spennithorne</u> from 3.30 pm - 4.30 pm on a Wednesday during the second half of the term. This is open to children across the federation. Children who are taught at Middleham will be bussed to Spennithorne at the end of the day in time for the club to start at 3.30 pm. Seats on the bus will be on a first come, first served basis. Sessions will start on 8th November and end on 13^{th} December. The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £18.00 for the whole term – 6 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).

Eco Club

Miss O'Neill and Mrs Wheeler will be leading Eco Club sessions every Friday from 3.15pm – 4.15pm commencing 15th September until 15th December at Middleham School. Spaces are limited so please book your child's place ASAP by contacting Mrs Durrant to avoid disappointment. Priority will be given to children who were on the waiting list and then allocated on a first come first served basis.

Your child will need to bring the following kit: waterproofs, wellies, hat, gloves, old clothes, water bottle. All items need to be named, in a bag to change into at the end of the school day before the session starts.

The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £39.00 for the whole term – 13 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).
