Music Club (for all ages)

Mr Whawell (from Sing Education) will be running a Music Club this term for all school years. It will run every Monday from 3.15pm to 4.15pm at Middleham commencing Monday 15th January until Monday 18th March. This is open to children across the federation. This club is free for all children.

Children who are taught at Middleham will be bussed to Spennithorne at the end of the day in time for the club to start at 3.30pm. Seats on the bus will be on a first come, first served basis. Sessions will start on Wednesday 10th January and end on Wednesday 7th February.

The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £15.00 for the whole term – 5 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).

Well-Being Club (2nd Half Term only for all ages)

Miss Peacock will be leading a Well-Being Club <u>at Spennithorne</u> from 3.30pm – 4.30pm on a Wednesday during the second half of the term. This is open to children across the federation. Children who are taught at Middleham will be bussed to Spennithorne at the end of the day in time for the club to start at 3.30pm. Seats on the bus will be on a first come, first served basis. Sessions will start on Wednesday 21st February and end on Wednesday 13th March.

The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £12.00 for the whole term – 4 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).

Eco Club

Miss O'Neill, Mrs Wheeler and Miss Peacock will be leading Eco Club sessions every Friday from 3.15pm – 4.15pm commencing 12th January until 15th March at Middleham School. Spaces are limited so please book your child's place ASAP by contacting Mrs Durrant to avoid disappointment. Priority will be given to children who were on the waiting list and then allocated on a first come first served basis.

Your child will need to bring the following kit: waterproofs, wellies, hat, gloves, old clothes, water bottle. All items need to be named, in a bag to change into at the end of the school day before the session starts.

The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £27.00 for the whole term – 9 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).
