Music Club (for all ages)

Mr Whawell (from Sing Education) will be running a Music Club this term for all school years. It will run every Monday from 3.15pm to 4.15pm at Middleham commencing Monday 15th April until Monday 15th July. This is open to children across the federation.

Sports Club

Mr Bullock will be leading a Sports club at Middleham on a Tuesday from 3:15pm to 4:15pm at Middleham. The children will be given the opportunity to explore a range of different sporting and fitness activities throughout the sessions. Sessions will start on Tuesday 9th April until Tuesday 16th July. This is open to children across the federation. The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £42.00 for the whole term – 14 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).

Science Club (1st Half Term only for all ages)

Miss Remmer will be running a Science Club <u>at Spennithorne</u> from 3.30pm – 4.30pm on a Tuesday during the first half of the term. This is open to children across the federation. Children who are taught at Middleham will be bussed to Spennithorne at the end of the day in time for the club to start at 3.30pm. Seats on the bus will be on a first come, first served basis. Sessions will start on Tuesday 9th April and end on Tuesday 21st May. Spaces are limited so please book your child's place ASAP by completing the attached form to avoid disappointment.

The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £21.00 for the half term – 7 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).

Games Club

Miss Peacock will be leading a Games Club on a Thursday from 3:15pm to 4:15pm at Middleham. Sessions will start on Thursday 11th April until Thursday 11th July.

The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £39.00 for the whole term – 13 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).

Miss O'Neill, Miss Crabbe and Miss Peacock will be leading Eco Club sessions every Friday from 3.15pm – 4.15pm commencing 12th April until Friday 12th July at Middleham School. Your child will need to bring the following kit: waterproofs, wellies, hat, gloves, old clothes, water bottle. All items need to be named, in a bag to change into at the end of the school day before the session starts.
