Autumn Term 2025 Extra-Curricular Clubs

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to share with you a timetable of extra-curricular enrichment clubs that will be happening across our federation during the Autumn Term 2025. Please note all clubs will start week beginning 8th September 2025. There will be no clubs week beginning 15th December 2025 due to our Christmas end of term events.

I am very grateful to staff members who volunteer to run these extra-curricular clubs for the children. We will be running various clubs at lunchtime and after school at each school site. Our lunchtime offer is available for all the children (there is no booking form for these clubs), but in particular for those children who cannot stay after school so that they still get the opportunity to attend a club.

Please note that booking of places for all after school clubs is now made directly with ParentPay and must be complete before 31st August 2025 to confirm a place in the club, once payment has been made you will automatically receive a confirmation email from ParentPay and we will confirm your child has a place when we return to school on Monday 1st September.

Outside Explorers Club

Miss Remmer and Miss Crabbe will lead an Outside Explorers Club at Spennithorpe on a Monday from 3.30-4.30pm. Children across the federation will come together to explore outside, including the garden, forest area and so much more! Sessions will run from 8th September to 20th October. The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £21.00 for the first half term (7 sessions, payable through Parent Pay).



Christmas Club

Miss Remmer and Miss Crabbe will lead a Christmas Arts & Crafts Club at Spennithorne on a Monday from 3.30-4.30pm. Children across the federation will come together to make a variety of different Christmas themed items. Sessions will run from 3rd November to 8th December. The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £18.00 for the half term (6 sessions, payable through Parent Pay).

Sports Club

Simon Carson Sports Club will be leading a Sports club at Spennithorne on a Tuesday from 3:30pm to 4:30pm. The children will be given the opportunity to explore a range of different sporting and fitness activities throughout the sessions. Sessions will start on 9th September to 9th December. The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £39.00 for the whole term (13 sessions, payable through Parent Pay). Oak and Sycamore children will be transferred to Spennithorne on the federation shuttle bus.

GOAL – Game of Actual Life

Simon Carson Sports Club will be leading the Game of Actual Life Club at Middleham for Sycamore and Oak Class on a Thursday from 3.15 – 4.15pm. This is a life skills programme where the children role-play as a 22 year old and will learn about:

- Buying a house
- Managing finances
- Getting a job
- How pensions work
- Car Insurance... And much more!

Sessions will start on 11th September to 11th December. The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £39.00 for the whole term (13 sessions, payable through Parent Pay).
