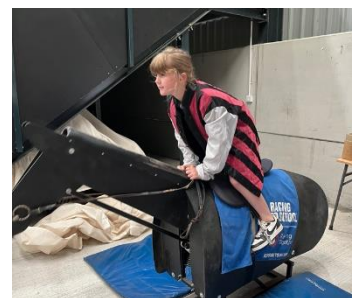
## Inspired Chocolate

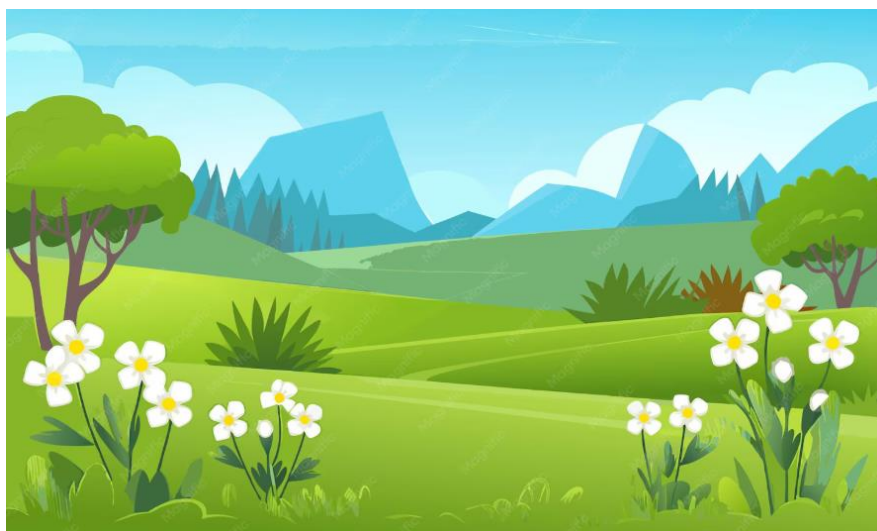
