Music Club (for all ages)

Mr Whawell (from Sing Education) will be running a Music Club **at Middleham** this term for all school years. It will run every Monday from 3.15pm to 4.15pm commencing Monday 15th January until Monday 18th March. This is open to children across the federation. Baking Club

The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £27.00 for the whole term – 9 weeks. All clubs are payable through Parent Pay.

Lego Club (1st Half Term only for all ages)

Miss Peacock will be leading a Lego Club from 3.30pm – 4.30pm on a Wednesday during the first half of the term. This is open to children across the federation. Sessions will start on Wednesday 10th January and end on Wednesday 7th February at Spennithorne School.

The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £15.00 for the whole term – 5 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).

Well-Being Club (2nd Half Term only for all ages)

Miss Peacock will be leading a Well-Being Club from 3.30pm – 4.30pm on a Wednesday during the second half of the term. This is open to children across the federation. Sessions will start on Wednesday 21st February and end on Wednesday 13th March at Spennithorne School.

The cost will be £3.00 per session and will be £12.00 for the whole term – 4 weeks (payable through Parent Pay).
